- Have you heard about Jesus? What have you heard about Him? [die on cross, son of God]
- What do you know about Jesus dying on the cross? What do you think Jesus wants people to do?
- Has anyone ever shown you from the Bible who Jesus is and what He wants from us? (**Mk. 8:27-38**)
